

### Last Day of School

Please note the changes to the last day of school for different groups:

If your child is in the Key Worker's group,

Reception, Year 1, Year 4 or Year 5, then their last day will be Friday 17<sup>th</sup>

July.

If your child is in Year 3 or Year 6, then their last day will be Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July.

Year 2 children who come on Monday and Tuesday will finish on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> and those who are in on Thursday and Friday will finish on Friday 17<sup>th</sup>.
