3 eras of the stone age

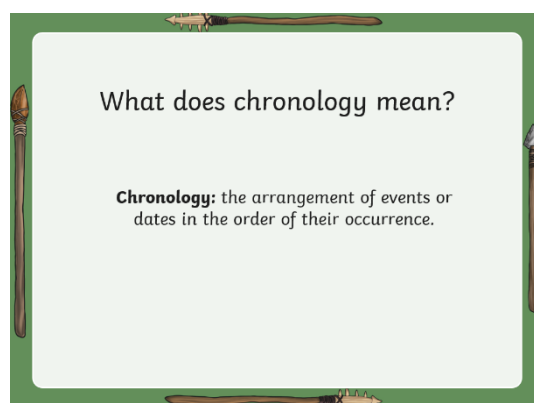


Prehistory is a time in human history before written records. We usually think of the time when people began to use tools (early stone age) up until when humans developed written communication. Towards the end of the Bronze age in the late neolithic era.

The stone age lasted roughly 2.5 million years. Wow! That's a long time.
