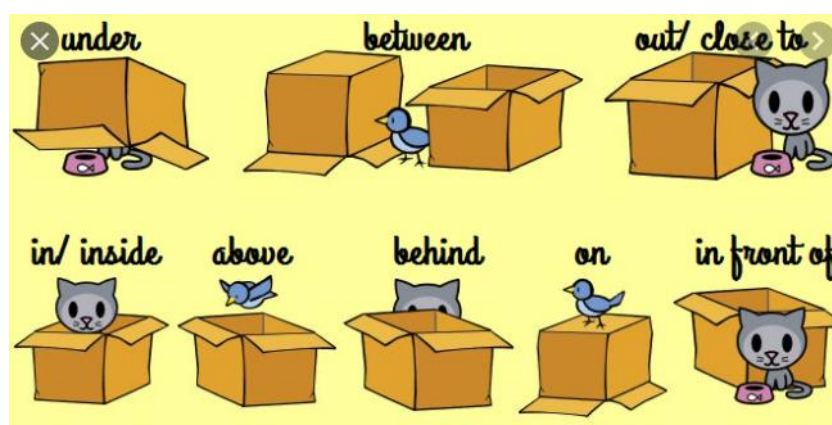

'At' is used for precise times	'In' is used for months, years, decades, centuries, and long periods of time	'On' is used for days and dates
