Feature	Purpose
Full stops and capital letters	<u>So</u> the sentences make sense and it's easy to see where a new sentence begins.
Adjectives	To give the reader a picture in their minds or what the dragon looks like.
Accurate verbs	To tell my reader exactly what the dragon is doing Instead of <i>the dragon came out</i> use, <i>the dragon crawled out</i> .
No missing words	My writing makes sense and it is easy for the reader to understand.
