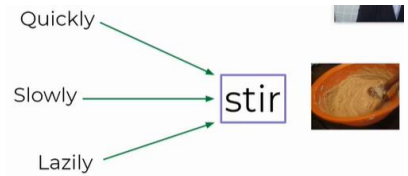
Instructions

Adverbs

In instructions we might see adverbs of **manner**. In instructions, these tell the reader how the action should be completed. These words often end in the letters ly.

Gently mix.
Carefully cut.
Generously spread.

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Instructions for making pizza

Do not try this without a parent or carer's help. Make sure you clear the space, pay close attention and be careful!
