



- ❖ Begin by looking at the panel to the left of the screen and select



to listen to the alphabet song. When finished, close it down.

**Now navigate to the tabs above the screen and go through them in order.**

1. Click on the **'Sounds tab'** to watch a short video introducing the sound.
2. Click on the **'Reading tab'** to practise blending words that have the sound in them for reading. Use the blue arrow to move to the next word.
3. The **'Spelling tab'** will give you the choice of pictures to see or words to listen to then spell- at school we do both. You can drag the magnetic letters into the boxes to spell the words. At school we write the words in our phonics books.
4. The **'Writing tab'** models how to correctly form the letters that represent the sound. The children will need to practise with pens and paper.
5. At school we **'Follow up'** with activities in the classroom- at home you can look at the 'Phonics Bloom' games.
