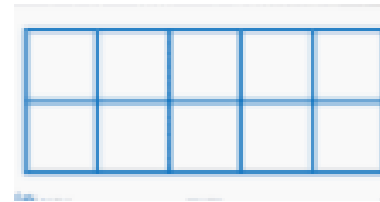


Maths, March 3rd

Number Bonds to 10



- Find a large piece of paper and draw a tens frame like this
- Try and make it as large as you can.
- Hide 10 small items around your home or outdoors. Make sure all the items you are hiding are the same.
- Your child has to find the items and put them on the tens frame.
- Prompt your child to tell you how many items they have found and how many are still hiding – by using the tens frame.
