This week we are going to be playing some games to consolidate our learning of all the sounds that we have learnt this term.

Today and tomorrow we are going to be playing Bingo.

- Draw up a bingo sheet on a piece of paper (see next 2 slides) – you will need two different ones for two players.
- Draw up your bingo cards, separately on pieces of card or paper (ch/sh/th/ng/ai/ee/igh/oa/oo/ar/or/ur/j/v/w/x).
- Each player has a bingo sheet and the bingo cards are placed face down.
- When you are ready to start, a bingo card is turned over. If a player has this sound on their sheet, they put the card on that particular sound.
- When a player has all their sounds covered, they shout 'Bingo' and they are the winner!
