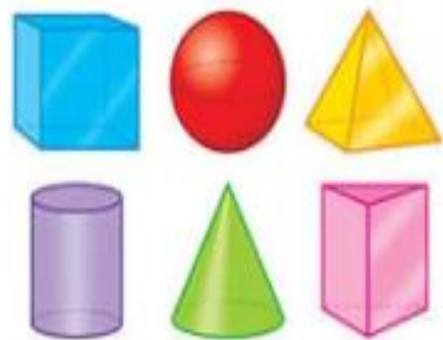
Your Maths activity today will be finding out about 3D shapes.

1. Go on the hunt in your home for different containers and shapes – boxes/balls/cans/tubes/tins (kitchen cupboards are a good source!)
2. Sort the shapes in to groups. You can sort them in any way you want
3. Ask “Why did you put these shapes together?” and “How is this set different to this one?” or “Is there another way to sort them?”
