Pairs

Number Bonds to 10



- Make 10 cards with the numbers 1 to 10 on.
- Cut out each card so that they are separate cards (you can use paper).
- Place cards face down.
- Child and adult take turns to turn over two cards.
- When they find a pair that adds up to 10, they keep the cards and have another go. If there isn't a pair, the other player takes their go.
- The player who collects the most cards wins.
- You can always practice recording your number bonds with pencil/paper

As an extra challenge, you could explore number bonds to 20. However, this is only if your child is completely secure with the number bonds from 1 to 10.
