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Splat!

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Instructions



- We have reached the end of half term and you have learnt so many sounds! Well done everybody! Don't worry if you don't know them all, we will spend the last part of reception class going over what you have learnt.
- You have to play a game today and tomorrow. We have played it in class, so you will remember!
- Ideally, it is for 2 players and a referee but if there is only you and an adult, you can still play.
- Write the sounds on a piece of paper (a small piece of paper for each sound).
- Cut out each sound/paper.
- Spread them across the floor. The referee calls out a sound and the two players race to splat (put their hand on) the sound called. The person that gets there first keeps the card behind them. This is repeated until all sounds have been called. The winner is the one with the most cards at the end.
- If only two people can play, the adult can call out the sound and the child can splat the sound. If they feel confident, they can call the sound and the adult can splat it.
